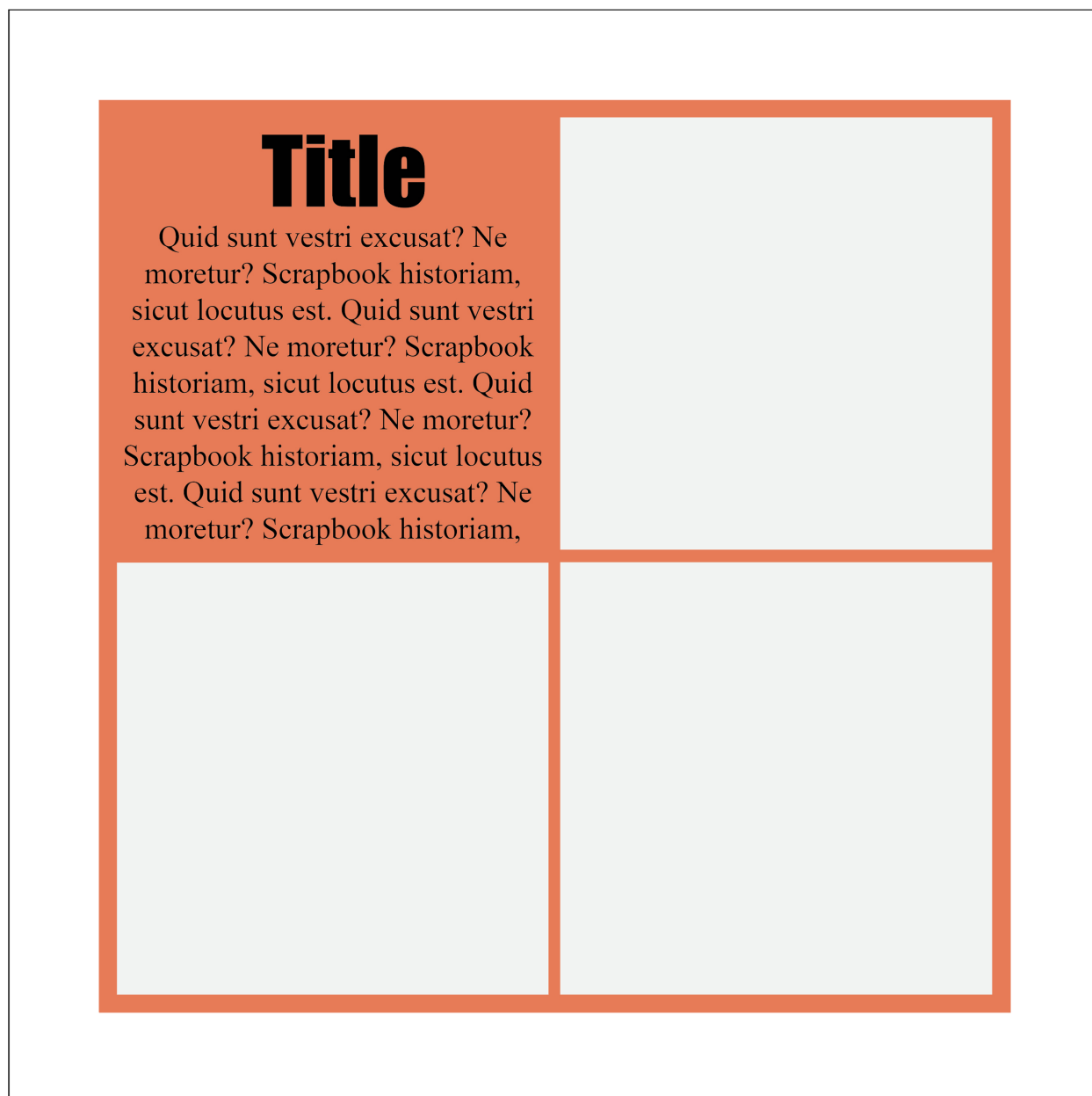


No Excuse Scrapbooking

What's stopping you from starting?

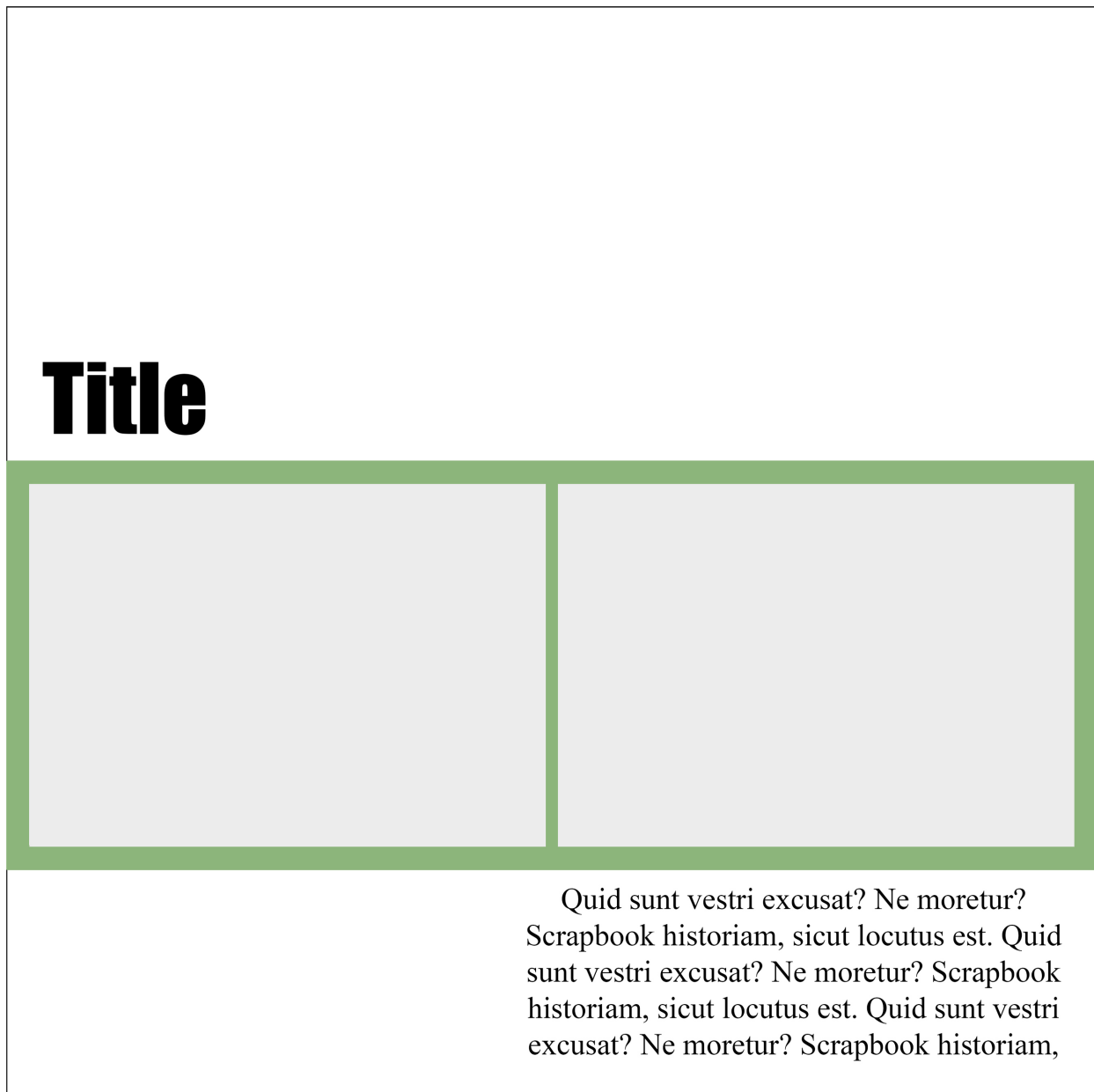

The Square layout



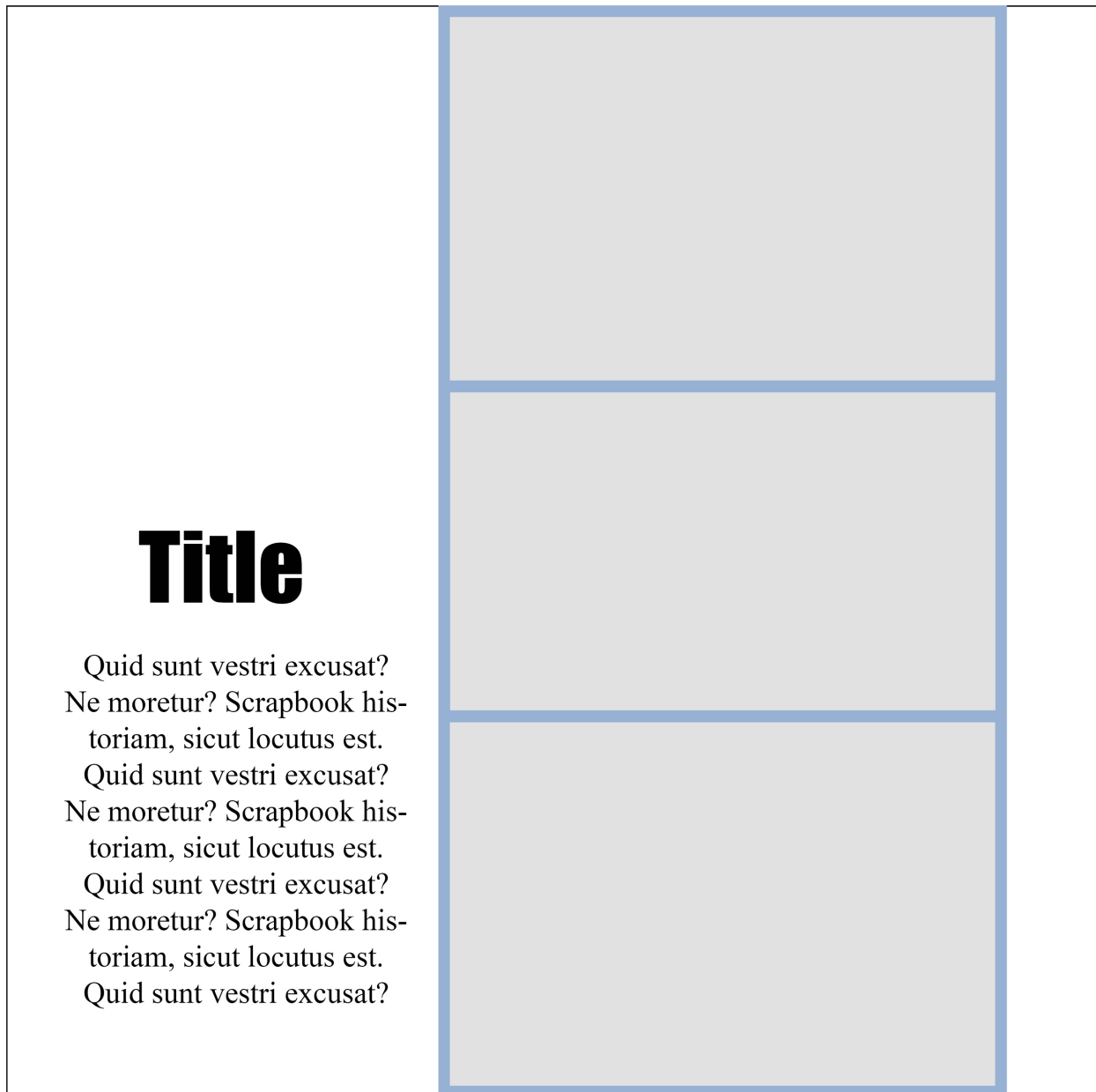
Square (or grid) layout

The Horizontal Band Layout



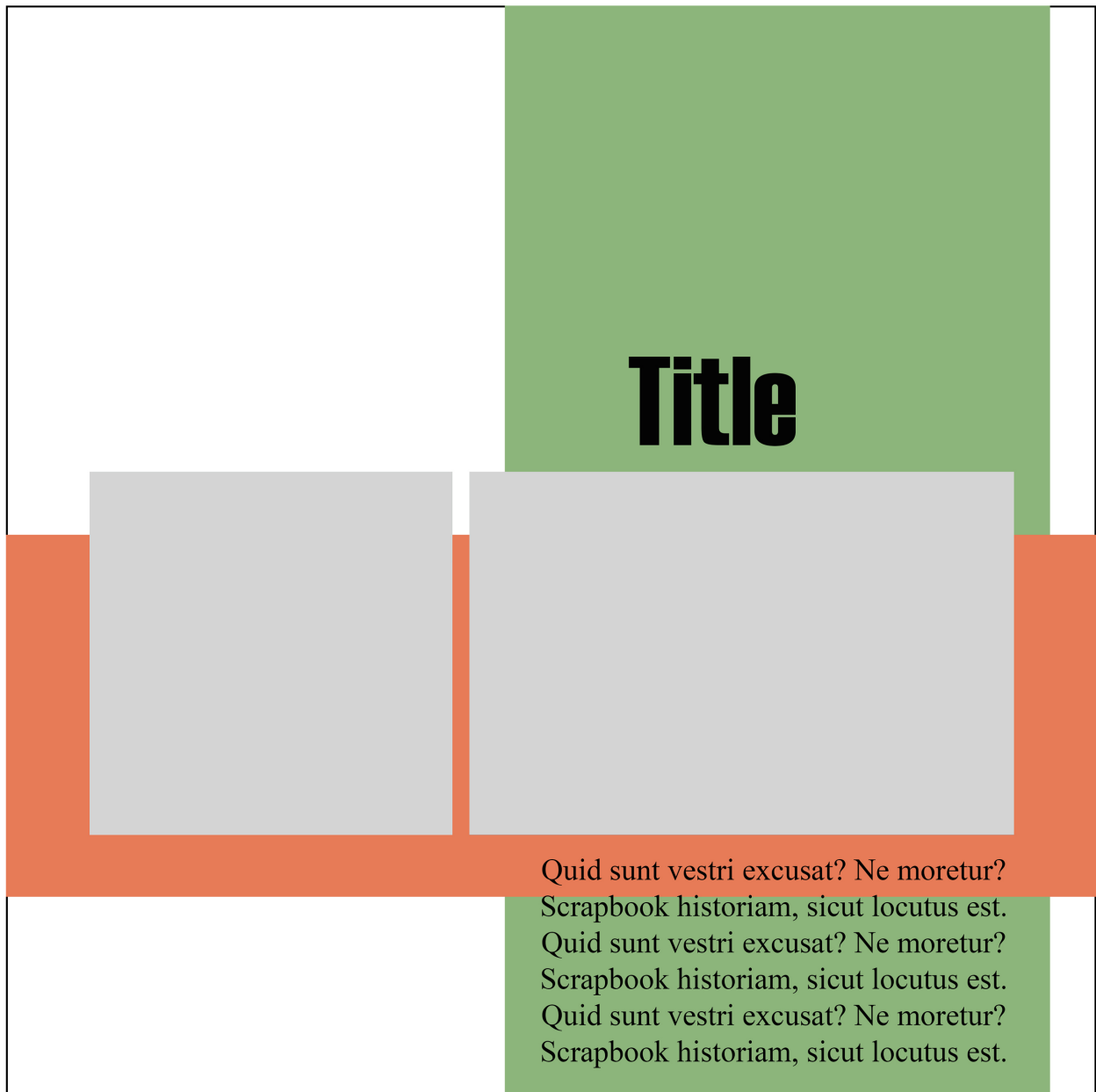
Horizontal band layout

The Vertical Band Layout



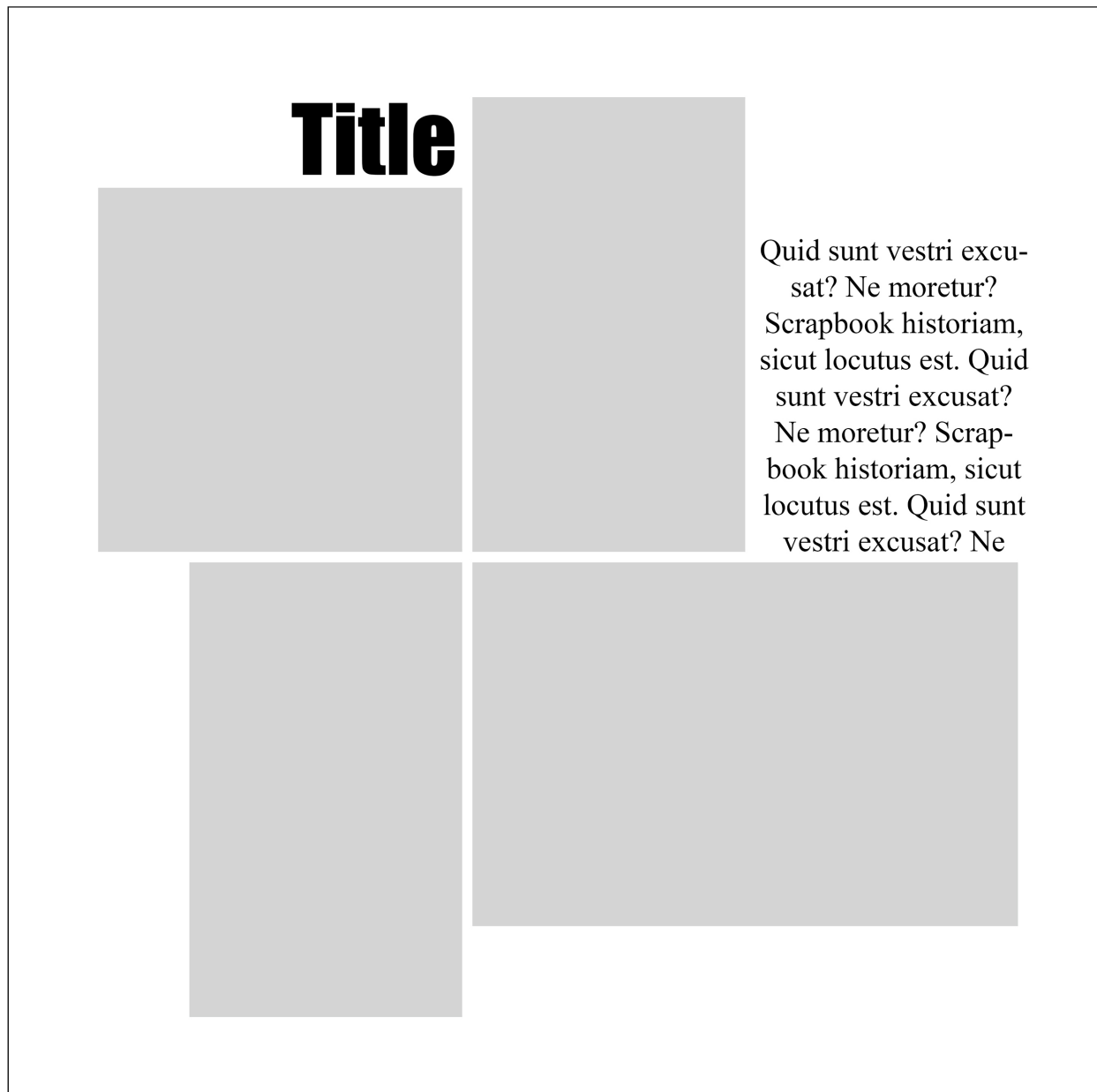
Vertical band layout

The T Layout



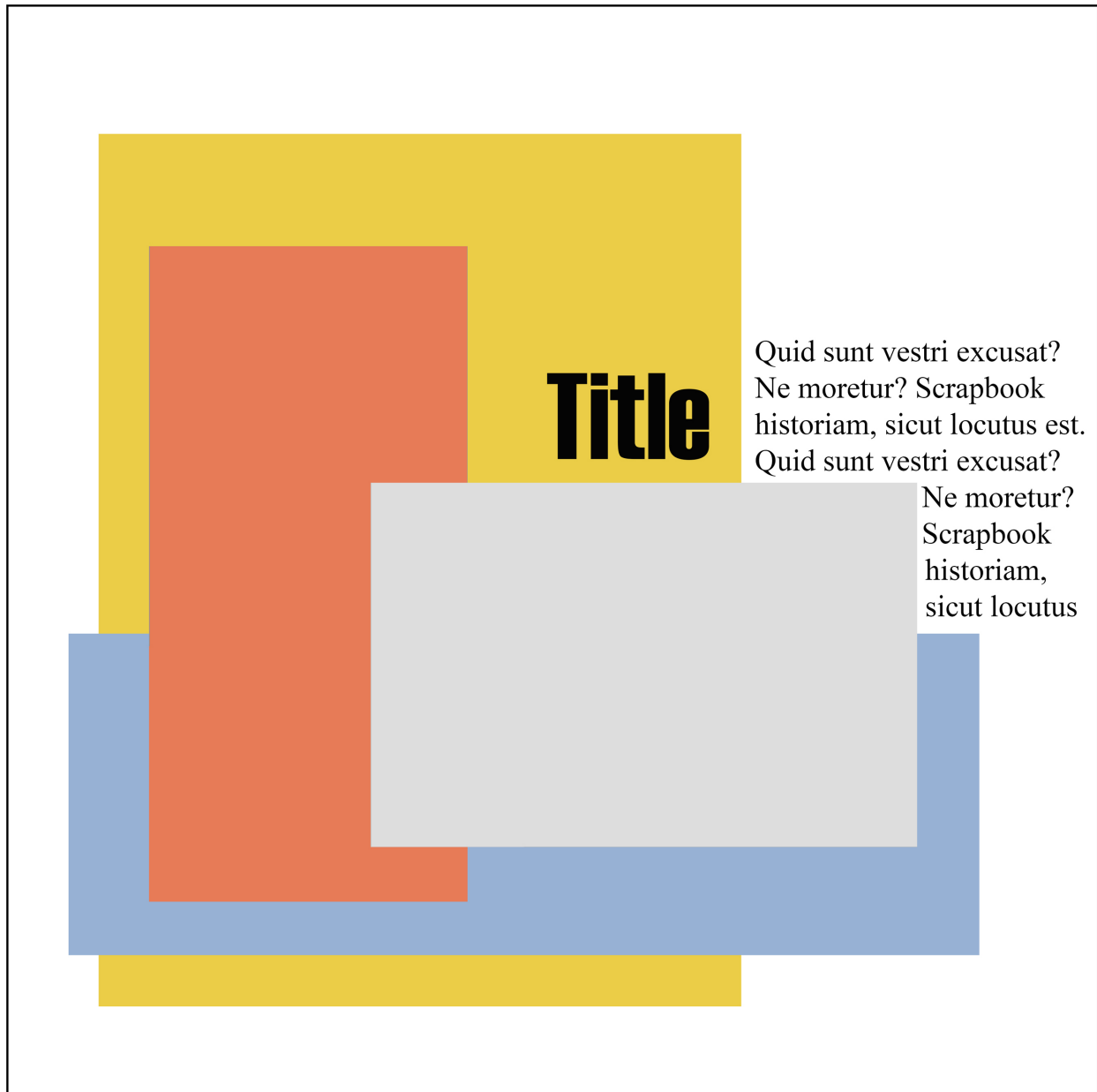
T sketch

The Pinwheel Layout



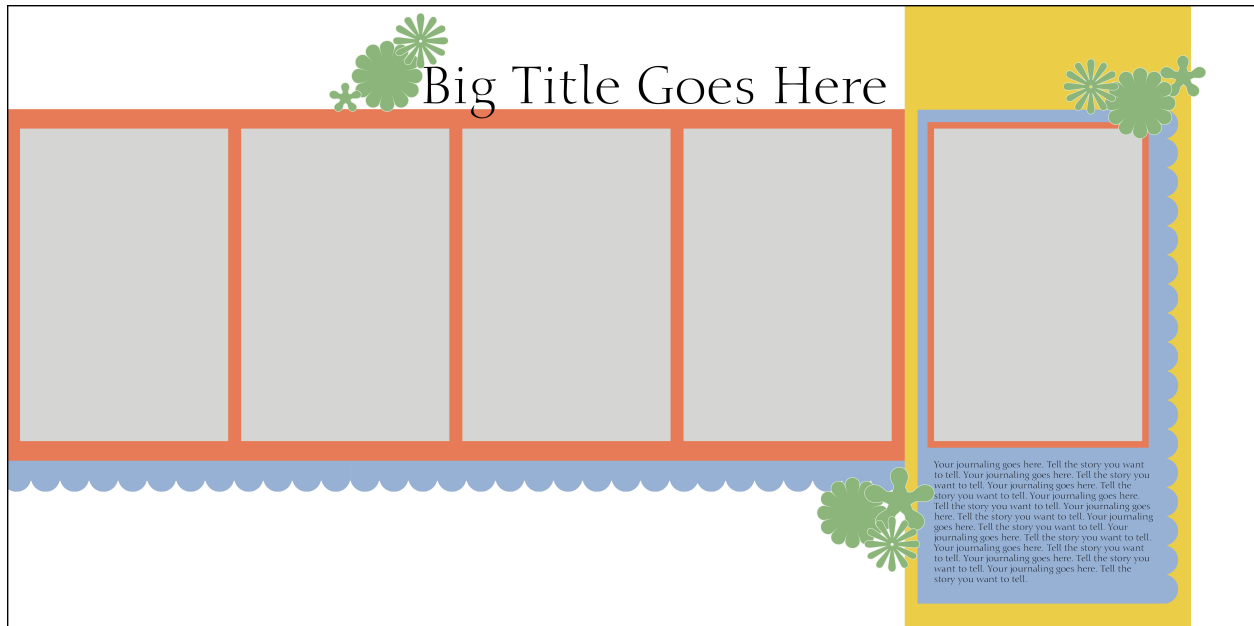
Pinwheel layout
